

Urgent measures relating to the epidemiological emergency by COVID-19

The Council of Ministers, on the proposal of President Mario Draghi and Minister of Health Roberto Speranza, approved a decree-law that introduces urgent measures relating to the epidemiological emergency from COVID-19.

In view of the evolution of the epidemiological curve and the state of implementation of the vaccination plan, the text modifies the **parameters of entry into the "colored areas"**, according to criteria proposed by the Minister of Health, so that the **incidence of infections** in relation to the population as a whole, as well as **the occupancy rate of beds in the medical area and in intensive care**, are of major importance.

In addition, in the "**yellow zones**" significant, though gradual, modifications are expected. The main ones are as follows:

- From the entry into force of the decree, **the prohibition of travel** due to reasons other than work, need or health, currently provided for from 22.00 to 5.00, will be reduced by one hour, remaining **valid from 23.00 to 5.00. From 7 June 2021**, it will be valid from **24.00 to 5.00. From 21 June 2021 will be completely abolished;**
- **From 1 June it will be possible to eat food and drinks inside the premises even after 18.00**, until the closing time provided for by travel regulations;
- **From May 22**, all shops in the **markets, shopping centers, galleries and shopping parks** can be **reopened even on public holidays and pre-holidays;**
- **From May 24 will be the reopening of gyms;**
- **From 1 July** will be able to reopen the **indoor swimming pools, swimming centers, wellness centers**, in compliance with the guidelines and protocols;
- **From 1 June outdoors and from 1 July indoors, the presence of the public will be allowed**, within the limits already provided (25% of the maximum capacity, with the limit of 1,000 people outdoors and 500 indoors), **for all competitions or sporting events** (not only those of national interest);
- **From May 22nd** it will be possible to reopen **the ski lifts in the mountains**, in compliance with the sector guidelines;
- **From 1 July, arcades, betting rooms, bingo halls and casinos will be able to reopen to the public;**
- **Theme and amusement parks will be able to reopen to the public from June 15th, instead of July 1st;**
- **All activities of cultural centers, social centers and leisure centers will be possible again from 1st July;**

- **From June 15th, parties and receptions following civil or religious ceremonies** will be possible, even indoors, **through the use of the "green certification"**. **Activities in dance halls, discos and the like, outdoors or indoors, remain suspended;**
- **From 1 July** it will be possible to hold **public and private training courses in presence.**

Information for vaccinations:

From Monday 17 May, in Emilia Romagna **over 40s** can register online for the administration of the **anti-Covid** vaccine by connecting to the website of the Region

The procedure is **simple and universal**, open to foreign people legally residing and also to **foreign citizens** holding an **ENI, STP or PSU** code.

ATTENTION: to access **it is not necessary to have a SPID**. Simply click on the gray button "Log in by entering your data" and then fill in the form with your personal data, taking care to select the age group concerned ("**People not assisted or residents aged 40 or over**").

In particular, without prejudice to the administrative flexibility provided, with regard to the documents required, for the vaccination of all socially fragile people, the opportunity was brought to the attention of the Minister to proceed to define at national level homogeneous and fully payable paths that ensure the widest vaccination coverage for such individuals, for the benefit of public health.
