Dear Minister,

we would like to bring to your attention the concern, which in recent weeks is represented to us by numerous municipalities, referring to the difficulties of access to the vaccination plan for hundreds of thousands of people in particularly fragile conditions and difficult to reach, starting from people without a fixed home or identification documents.

We are aware of the clear and incontrovertible picture of the universal right to health, sanctioned by our Constitution, in which access to vaccinations is fully inserted, finally explicitly highlighted also by AIFA, with reference to those who are without identification documents.

However, there are significant critical issues regarding the actual exercise of this right. Considering, first of all, the impossibility to access the vaccine booking platforms in the absence of a tax code and / or health card, or the difficulty of reaching and raising awareness of these population groups on the subject of vaccines.

The concerns of the mayors stem from the lack of vaccination and the lack of precise indications, in the persistent pandemic framework, of large sections of the population and therefore it seems important to define at national level homogeneous and fully enforceable paths that guarantee the widest coverage of vaccine.

Remaining at your disposal for any further joint evaluation, certain of a reply, we send you our best regards.
